STEP 3 PARENT PARTICIPATION: Each family at CMLL is required to commit an adult to help with one of the activities below (3/3.5 hours unless RAFFLE chosen). \$45 is the CMLL Parent Participation Deposit which is collected upfront. Upon fulfillment of the activity, the \$45 returns to the family. (Those who select the Snack Stand or Pitch, Hit & Run activity are refunded their \$45 upon completion of the 3/3.5 hour work shift. If the Raffle is selected, parents recover their \$45, and then some, when they sell their tickets.) CMLL will retain the \$45 if a family opts out of helping with any of the activities so that substitute labor may be secured.
